Eligibility conditions

As per prospectus of 2018-19.

Any Indian Citizen will be eligible to appear in the B. Pharmacy course, however for reservation policy any of the following categories shall be considered:

i) The candidates, who are bonafide residents of Haryana as per instructions issued by the Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana Chandigarh vide letter No.62/1795-6GSI dated 3.10.96 and submit relevant certificate of bonafide residents as laid down in letter no. 22/28/2003-3GS-III dated 30.1.2004

ii) The children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of the employees of Indian Defence Services/Para-Military Forces belonging of Haryana state at the time of entry into service as per their service record. (Such candidates will submit a certificate in the prescribed proforma from the Officer duly authorised by the Army/Navy/Air Force/concerned Para-Military Forces Headquarters, as the case may be).

iii) The children/ward (if parents are not living)/ dependents of Ex-employees of Indian Defence Services/Para-Military Forces belonging of Haryana state at the time of entry into service as per their service record who retired from service on or after First April of the preceding year of admission. (Such candidates will submit a certificate in the prescribed proforma from the Officer duly authorised by the Army/Navy/Air Force/concerned Para-Military Forces Headquarters, as the case may be).

iv) The children/ward (if parents are not living)/ dependents of Ex-employees of Indian Defence Services/Para-Military Forces belonging of Haryana state at the time of entry into service as per their service record, provided the candidates has studied 10+2 as a regular candidate in a recognized institution in Haryana. (Such candidates will submit a certificate in the prescribed proforma from the Officer duly authorised by the Army/Navy/Air Force/concerned Para-Military Forces Headquarters, as the case may be and also a certificate to the effect that he/she has studied 10+2 as a regular candidate in a recognised institution in Haryana from the Principal/Head of the Institution last attended in the prescribed proforma current prosepsects.

B.Pharmacy :- The candidates should also fulfill the FOLLOWING minimum conditions to become eligible for the admission:-

1. He/She should attain the age of 17 years or more on 31st December of admission year. The age shall be determined as per

entry in the Matriculation/Secondary school or its equivalent examination certificate.

2. Candidate shall be medically fit to pursue the course.

3. Candidate shall have passed 10+2 examination conducted by the respective state/ central government authorities recognised as equivalent to 10+2 examination by the Association of Indian University (AIU) with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (P.C.M) ans or Biology (P.C.M.) and or Biology (P.C.B/ P.C.M.B) as optional subjects individually. Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India equivalent to any of the above examinations.

B.Pharmacy Lateral entry (Second Year) (LEET)

A pass in D. Pharm. Course from an institution approved by the Pharmacy Council of India under section 12 of the Pharmacy Act.

M. Pharmacy

1. He/she must attain the age of minimum 21 years on 31st December of current admission year.

Note:- The age shall be determined as per entry in the Matriculation/Higher Secondary or its equivalent certificate.

2. The candidate must have passed B. Pharm. from AICTE/PCI approved institution, with minimum of 55% (50% for SC/BC) aggregate marks.

3. Candidate shall be medically fit to pursue the course.

4. Candidate shall be a citizen of India.


5. The provisional admission shall be made strictly in order of merit of valid GPAT score, if the seats(s) remain vacant, vacant seats shall be offered to Non-GPAT candidate (s) strictly in order of merit based on marks obtained in theory subjects of B. Pharmacy Course obtained from only AICTE/PCI approved Institutions.

6. Candidates must submit the proof of VALID GPAT SCORE for getting fellowship from AICTE and having passed qualifying examination, i.e. B. Pharmacy, at the time of counseling.
